SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION PROPOSITION 2

Shall the Board of Education of the Brookfield R-III School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,200,000) for the purpose of providing funds to replace and update the current track and field facility; to upgrade heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems and replace student lockers District-wide; to enhance the existing Elementary School playground; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6600 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
